Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpaths 25.49/5/1 Hovingham and 25.92/5/1 and 25.71/21/1 Stonegrave between grid reference SE66897798 and SE67557692 due to an unsafe bridge has been continued in force for a further twelve months until 7<sup>th</sup> September 2026 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

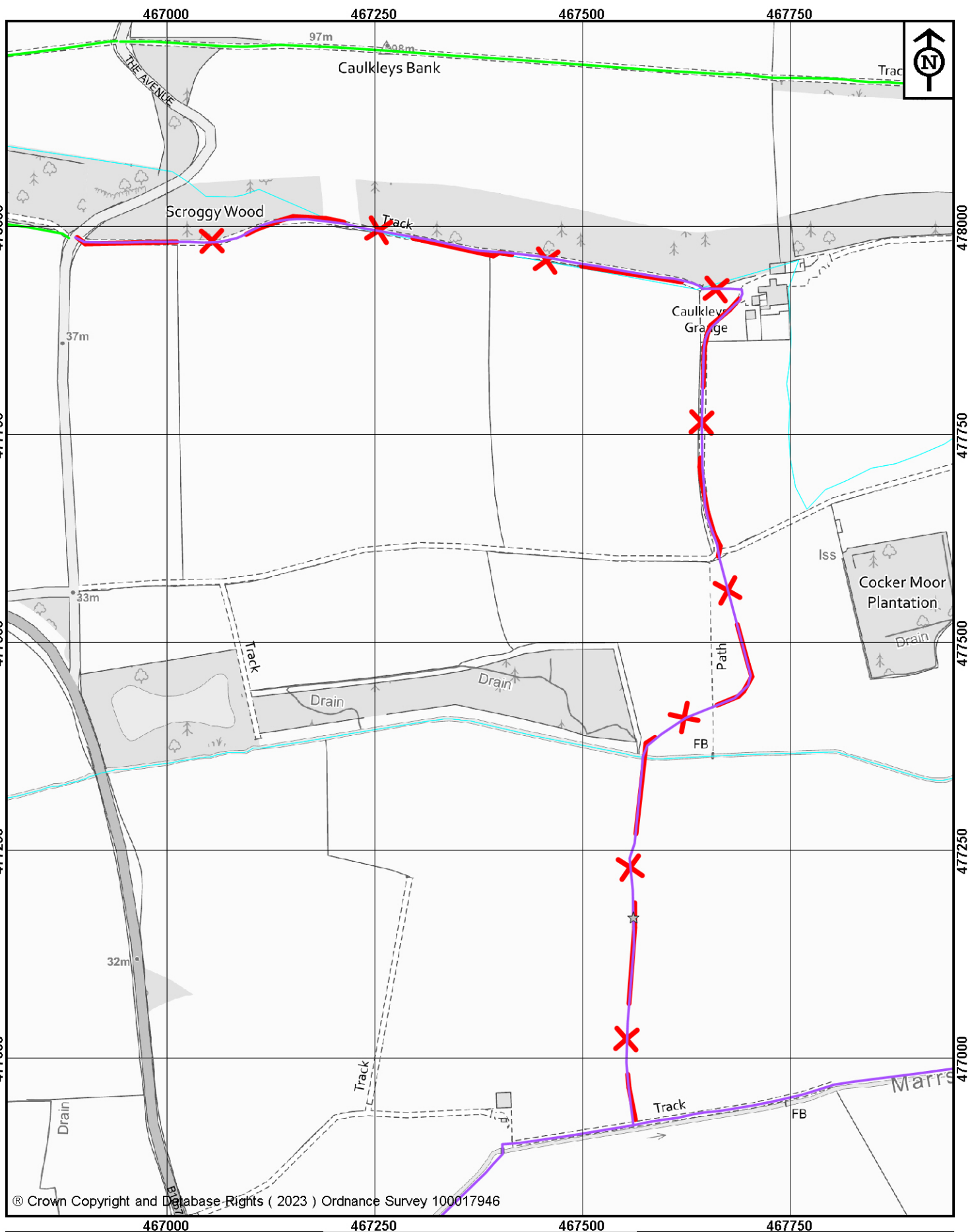
The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs.
