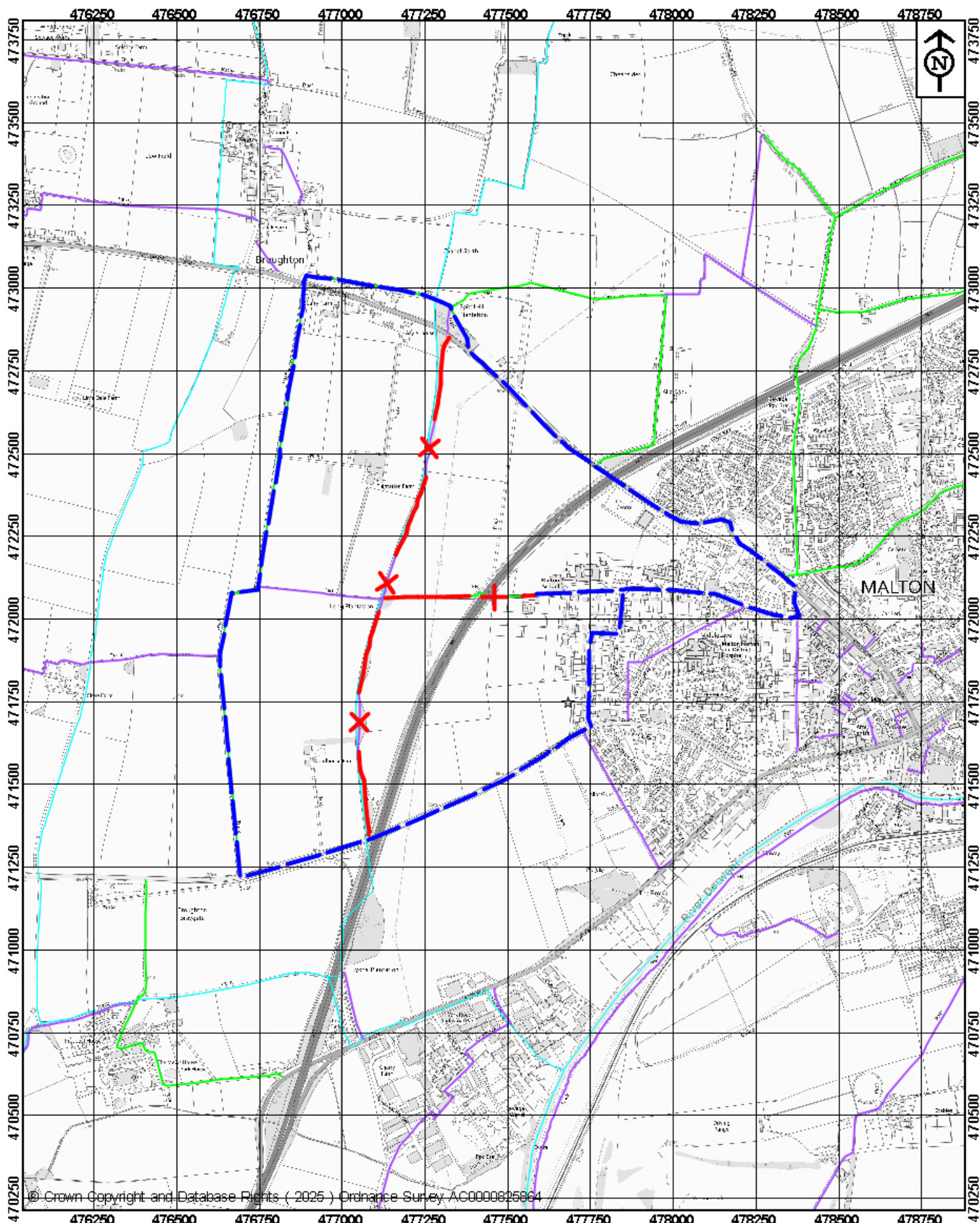
North Yorkshire Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using Public Bridleways 25.60/24/1, 25.60/45/1 and Public Footpaths 25.60/2/1, 25.60/2/3 & 25.60/39/1 in the Parish of Malton, between grid references SE77327285, SE77587207 & SE77077134 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025 and 12<sup>th</sup> April 2026 due to tree felling works.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.
