

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

### **Proposed Extension of 30mph Speed Limit: Gravelhill Lane, Whitley**

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order on one or more of the grounds contained in Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising,
2. for improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs,

The proposal seeks to achieve the following:

#### **Gravelhill Lane, Whitley**

- The extension of the 30mph speed limit from its current location 105m west of Cathcart Close side junction will be extended for 327m in a southwest direction. The existing national speed limit is inappropriate with regard to the level of development and characteristics of the road.
- The proposals are illustrated on Plan GRW1.
