NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpath 10.75/12/2 in the Parish of Ingleby Greenhow, between grid reference NZ57330546 and NZ57070508, due to a dangerous footbridge, has been continued in force for a further eighteen months until 24th April 2027 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

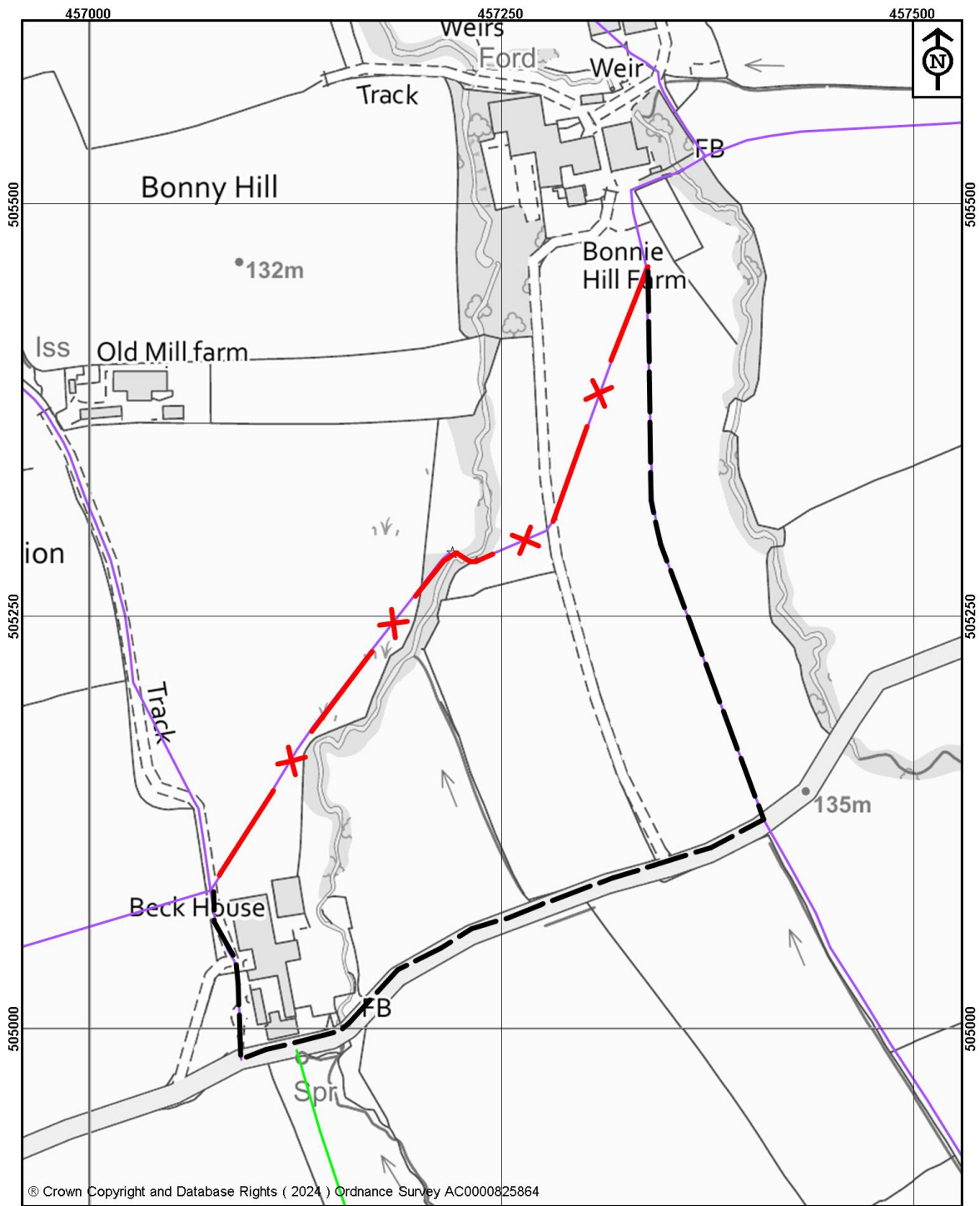
The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs. An alternative route will be signed on site.

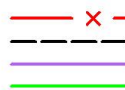
