NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 15.113/12, IVY HOUSE, ROECLIFFE, DIVERSION ORDER 2025

The above Order, made on 3rd October 2025, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the Public Footpath described below and modify The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement accordingly.

Public Footpath No.15.113/12 between 43770 46594 and 43787 46579 will be diverted onto a new route between 43769 46593 and 43787 46579.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Boroughbridge Community Library, 17 St James Square, Boroughbridge, YO51 9AR until 27th November 2025. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from Countryside Access Services, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 03001312131) at a cost of £2 or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Paul Dwyer, Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire DL7 8AD or email CATO@northyorks.gov.uk not later than 27th November 2025. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The North Yorkshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 15.113/12, IVY HOUSE, ROECLIFFE, DIVERSION ORDER 2025

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the occupier(s) of the land crossed by the Public Footpath described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Public Footpath should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Jayne Winn, Low Farm, Whixley, York, YO26 8AU has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

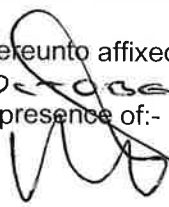
Roecliffe Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Ivy House, Roecliffe, and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority, and thereupon the The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be a Public Footpath over the land situated at Ivy House, Roecliffe, described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
3. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: install gate at point E and point F.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
5. The Former West Riding of Yorkshire Area 2 Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

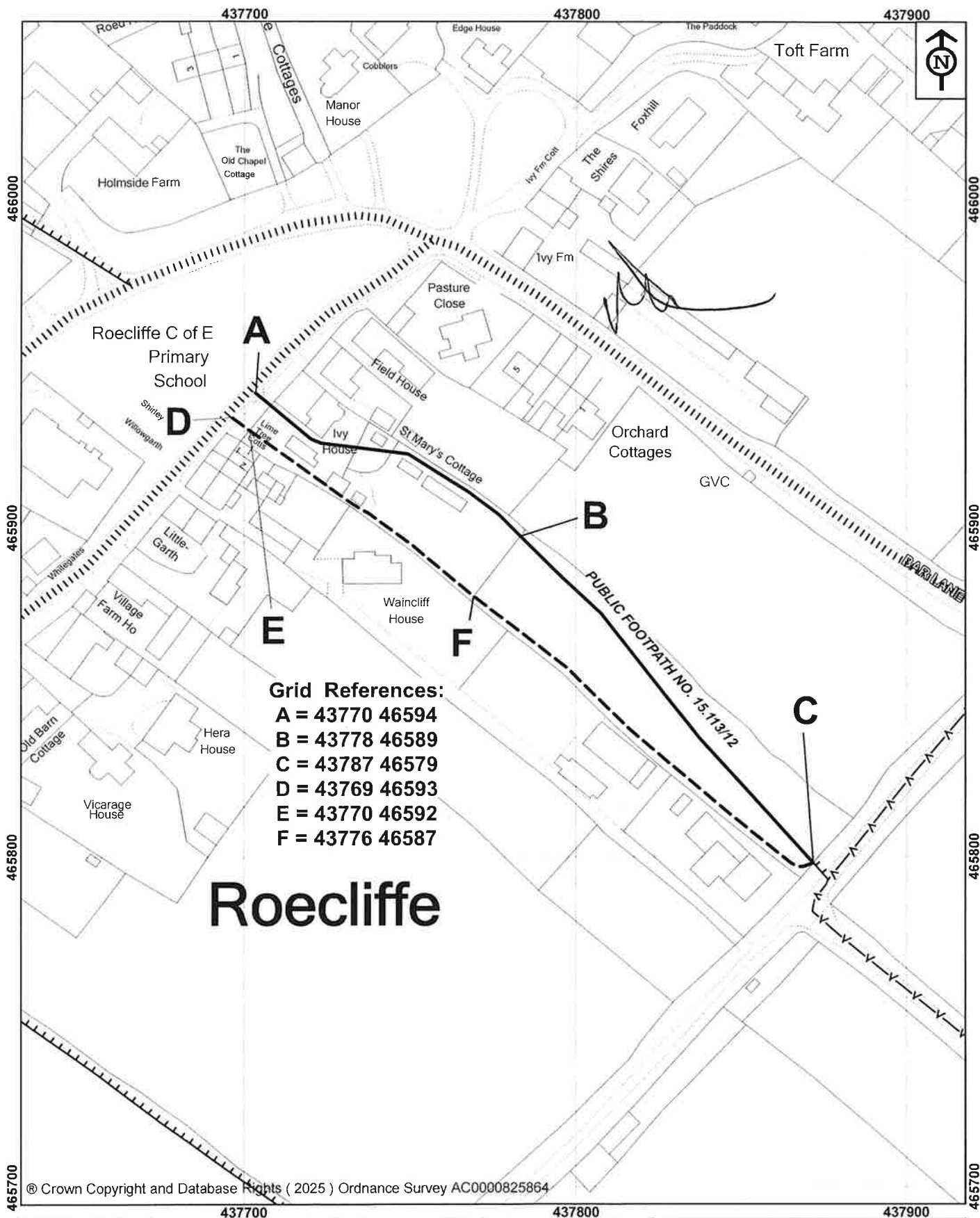
