NOTICE is hereby given that on 31 10 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 below and the speed limits in the Order described in Schedule 2 below are revoked as detailed in Column 2:-

3.	Clint Bank (C263), Burnt Yates	From its junction with the B6165 to a point 191.5 metres South of its intersection point with the Southern channel line of the B6165, measured along the centre line of Clint Bank
