(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (NEW ROAD, ULLESKELF) **ORDER 2025**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 31 10 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

1	New Road, Ulleskelf	Westerly direction from the existing 30mph speed limit for 300m

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 31 10 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
