(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (NORTON ROAD, NORTON-ON-DERWENT) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 04 11 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along any length of road specified in column 2 of the following Schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 3 of that Schedule.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 04 11 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
