3.	Matters arising:	
	<u>Unmoved Vessels</u>	
	AC had organised some cobles to be pointed, and concrete areas replaced	
	CH complained about 2 yrs of old gear mess (unused boats) not being moved.	

Cllr H noted that there were weeds in and around some boats. Cllr C stated boats need moving to clear areas under around them.	C.D.
GP suggested a meeting on site and walk around. CB stated labour needs organising from Harbours/Parks to move the vessels. GP requested details of whose vessels? Identification issue. Also how to move them?	GP
Cllr H noted some of their trailers were in poor condition.	
CB asked how harbours team can legally move damaged vessels? GP to explore powers to move vessels on land.	GP
Harbour users stated they can assist in identifying vessels at the site meeting. GP noted the vessel owners were still paying on an annual renewal so could be difficult to move.	
CBk – RNLI offered tractor D class to assist in moving vessels. RH also offered tractor,	RNLI/GP
Parking	
CBk mentioned Alan Brain manages permits for anglers, and there is no room to park now (25 members) that RNLI has been requested not park near Baker's Chalets on FCL. Requested permission to park on the commercial side of the landing. To be raised with Parking	Parking
RH advised he objects; its too busy, and should be clear on the commercial side. Ravine has area marked "permit holders".	
Cllr H noted the Parking wardens sporadic attendance and tourists/no- permit holders seemed happy to pay the fine.	
CB stated it had got worse since no FCL attendant and updated on recruitment problems for this post. Historically had a hut on the landing taking money for launches & parking.	
CB advised we could possibly to use the beach superintendent if we don't manage to hire a FCL attendant.	СВ
Cllr C stated traffic management is an issue and suggested a bollard?	
CB stated a bollard can be installed quite quickly but will present issues and is not preferred. Parking to invited on walk around.	СВ
CBk stated no signs were on the bottom side of the landing. RH advised it needs a commercial area, as bona fide permit holders have no place to park	
CB felt the issues would improve with an attendant. CB ask about beach attendant and see if it could be added to their duties.	СВ

	Cllr C stated speeding or misuse is causing a danger.	
	CB advised he is not aware of any bylaw, and not a lot we can do regarding jet skis on FCL.	
	 Most users considerate but a small number are not Speed restriction is 8 kts but no way to prove they are exceeding it NYC would probably lose a case against restricting jet skis and they will not fight the case. 	СВ
	CB ran through reasons jet skis cannot be prosecuted and promised to pass on details provided to him by SBC solicitor.	
	CB stated it could be a police issue in deciding misuse, but any CCTV which could be used should be council owned & operated	
	GP stated jet skis are now classed as vessels, and could complain to coastguard/MCA.
