

**THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**

**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)**  
**(NO 47) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to introduce the following restrictions in the table below:-

**WAITING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES**

| <b><u>Item</u></b> | <b><u>Location</u></b> | <b><u>Road</u></b> | <b><u>Side</u></b> | <b><u>Length</u></b>  |
|--------------------|------------------------|--------------------|--------------------|---|
| 1                  | Scotton                | Main Street        | West               | From the southern boundary line of Birch House for a distance of 104 metres in a north east direction to the boundary line of Lawrence House Farm |
| 2                  | Scotton                | Main Street        | East               | From a point 5 metres north of the southern boundary line of Pencob House for a distance of 97 metres in a north east direction                   |
