

**THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**

**PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)**  
**(NO 15) ORDER 2025**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that on 28 11 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to introduce the restrictions specified in the table 1 below:-

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 28 11 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
