(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF GATE HELMSLEY) **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

Item	Road	Length
1.	The Lane	From the centre line of its southern junction with A166, eastwards for a distance of 548 metres.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 02 02 2026, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Stamford Bridge Library, Church Road, York, YO41 1BP during normal office hours from 14 01 2026 until 17 02 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of make application to the High Court for the purpose.
