(20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(MAIN STREET, SCAGGLETHORPE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour and 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Part 1 and Part 2 below:-

Part 1

ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF SCAGGLETHORPE

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Main Street	From point measured 70 metres from the junction with the A64 to a point measured 41 metres from the centre of Southfields Junction.

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Main Street	From its junction with the A64 – 70 metres – to the access at the Ham and Cheese (PH.)
