**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

**PUBLIC FOOTPATH NOS. 20.26/1 & 20.8/3 & 20.8/4, ELLERTON ON SWALE & BOLTON ON
SWALE DIVERSION ORDER 2025.**

On 12.12.25, North Yorkshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the Public Footpaths described below and modify The District of Richmondshire (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map and Statement accordingly.

Public Footpath No. 20.26/1 between SE 2590 9864 and SE 2616 9823 will be diverted onto a new route between SE 2590 9858 and SE 2614 9822. Public Footpath No. 20.8/3 between SE 2580 9870 and SE 2590 9864 will be diverted onto a new route between SE 2580 9870 and SE 2590 9858. Public Footpath No. 20.8/4 between SE 2580 9870 and SE 2546 9846 will be diverted onto a new route between SE 2590 9858 and SE 2569 9839.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Colburn Community Library, North Yorkshire until 20.02.26. Copies of the Order and Map may be purchased from Countryside Access Service, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2.00, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

The Order comes into force on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, described in part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 09.01.26 make an application to the High Court.

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ON SWALE DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the Public Footpaths described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Public Footpaths should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The District of Richmondshire (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

Mr and Mrs Thompson of Laylands Farm, Ellerton on Swale, have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order.

Ellerton on Swale Parish Meeting has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Laylands Farm, Ellerton on Swale & Bolton on Swale and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of paths, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority, and thereupon The District of Richmondshire (outside the Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it these public rights of way. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above-mentioned certification be Public Footpaths over the land situated at Laylands Farm, Ellerton on Swale & Bolton on Swale described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon The District of Richmondshire (outside the Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by adding these paths to it.
3. The District of Richmondshire (outside The Yorkshire Dales National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
4. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: install pedestrian gates at Point C, F, G and I, install a field gate at Point H and undertake vegetation clearance between Point E and Point F.
5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

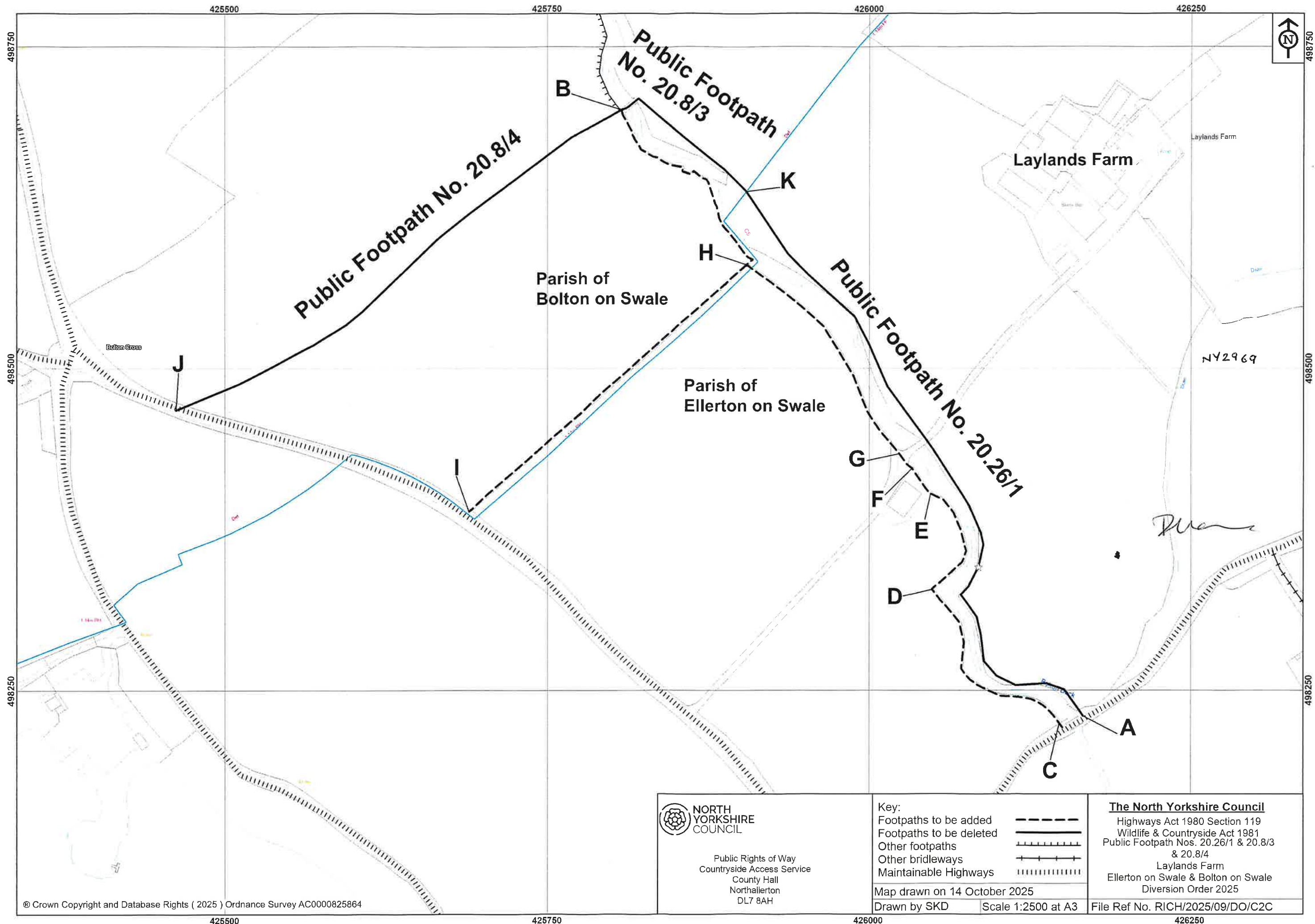
