

**THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL (20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMITS)  
(VARIOUS ROADS, ROECLIFFE) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 13 February 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 below and in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 below and to revoke the Traffic Regulation Order 'North Yorkshire County Council (Restricted Road) (C263, Roecliffe) Order 1996' insofar as it relates to Schedule 1 as detailed in Schedule 3 below :-
