NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any public access along Public Footpath 05.8/9/1 & 05.16/14/1 & 05.8/8/1 in the Parish of Broughton, between grid reference SD93515042 and SD93515085 due to bridge in need of repair, has been continued in force for a further twelve months until 9<sup>th</sup> February 2027 or until the completion of the works (whichever is the earlier), under Section 15(3) of the above Act with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

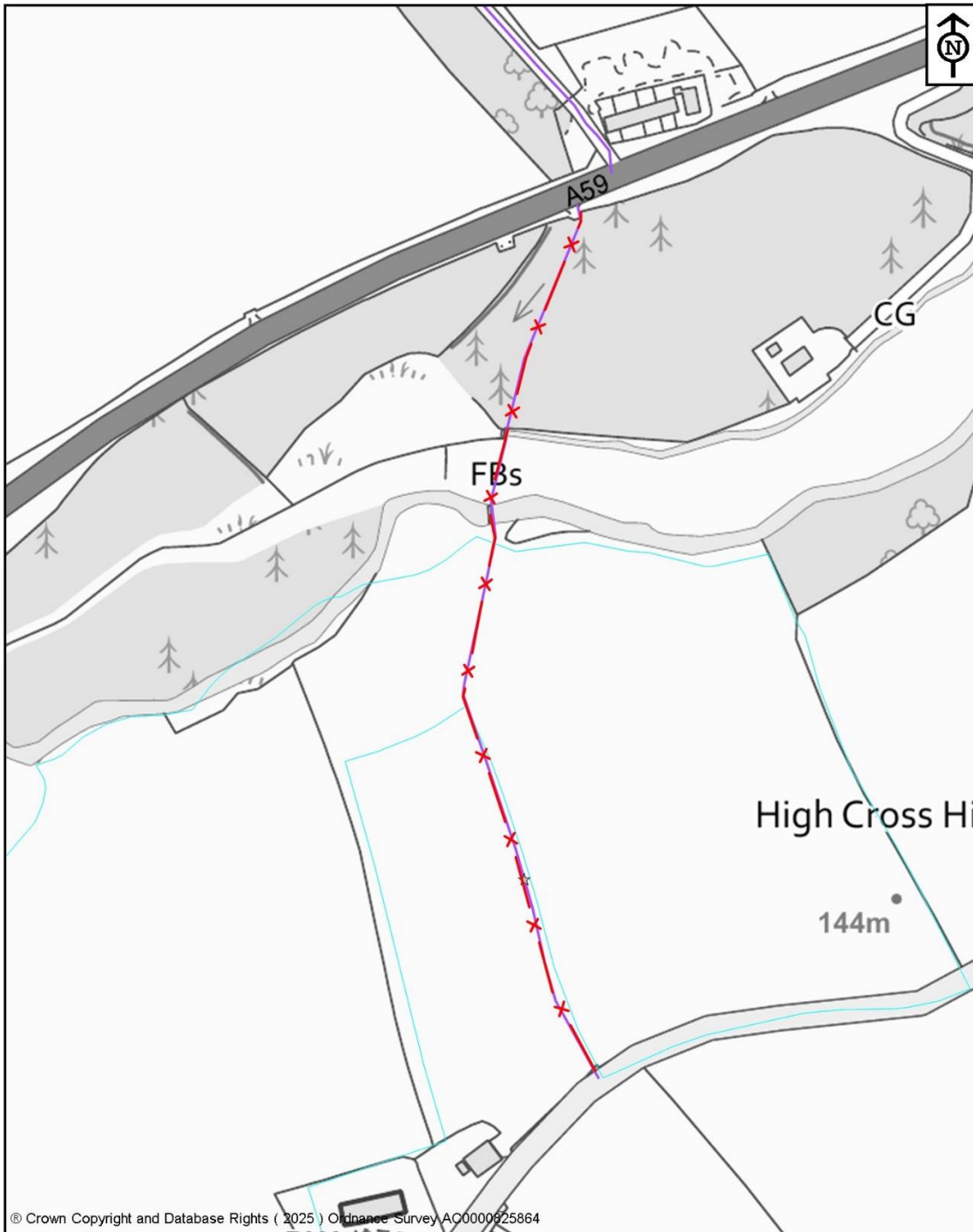
The further continuation of the closure will be put into effect by notices and signs.
