
**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as
amended)**

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using the Public Bridleway 10.56/11/1 in the Parish Great and Little Broughton between grid NZ53810872 and NZ53940798 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 2nd March 2026 and 1st September 2026 due to essential tree maintenance works.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.
