Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using the Public Bridleways 35.62/10/1 & 35.62/10/2 in the Parish of Stillingfleet between grid references SE59984296 and SE60824316 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 4th March 2026 and 10th August 2026 due to an unsafe bridge .This Order follows Emergency Notice No 37 which commenced 11th February 2026


The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
