Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)


North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 05.43/16/3 in the parish of Wigglesworth & 05.35/40/1 in the parish of Rathmell, between grid reference SD79665851 and SD79955943 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 3rd March 2026 and 9th August 2026 due to an unsafe bridge. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 34 which commenced on 10th February 2026.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
