PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(AMENDMENT NO 34) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 20 February 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Ryedale) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING

Location	Road	Side	Length	Nature of Restriction
Malton	Railway Street	Both	From a point 37 metres south of the centre line of its junction with Water Lane, to a point 23 metres south of the centre line of Railway Street Bridge.	Prohibition of Waiting between the hours of 08.00 and 18:00

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 02 March 2026, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Malton Library, St Michael Street, Malton, YO17 7LJ during normal office hours from 25 February 2026 to 03 April 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 20 February 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
