

**THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**

**PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)**  
**(AMENDMENT NO 33) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Ryedale) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

**SCHEDULE**

**PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ALL TIMES**

<b>Column 1 Item</b>	<b>Column 2 Road</b>	<b>Column 3 Side</b>	<b>Column 4 Length</b>
1.	High Street, Wilton	Northeast	From its junction with Cawcliff Lane, to a point 10 metres northwest of the centreline of its junction with Cawcliff Lane.
2.	Cliff Lane, Wilton	North	From its junction with Cawcliff Lane, to a point 38 metres east of the centreline of its junction with Cawcliff Lane.
3.	Cliff Lane, Wilton	South	From its junction with Cawcliff Lane, to a point 64 metres east of the centreline of its junction with Cawcliff Lane.
4.	Cawcliff Lane, Wilton	Southeast	From its junction with High Street, to a point 22 metres southwest of the centreline of its junction with High Street, including around the central island in the junction mouth.

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026, together with a map showing the roads affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Pickering Library, The Ropery, Pickering, North Yorkshire, YO18 8DY during normal office hours from 25<sup>th</sup> February 2026 to 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2026 and also viewed online at [www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map](http://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map) or [www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders](http://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders).

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 20<sup>th</sup> February 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
