



Council Tax 2026/27



What is Council Tax?

North Yorkshire Council must set a level of council tax to raise sufficient income to meet the expenditure requirements of providing its services. The council receives a share of government grant and a contribution from the business rate retention scheme. These receipts are deducted from the council's net expenditure requirement leaving the balance to be collected as council tax.

Calculating the Total Council Tax

North Yorkshire Council is required to collect £524.459 million of council tax to enable it to provide its services to the public.

The York and North Yorkshire Combined Authority and parish and town councils also request North Yorkshire Council to collect money on their behalf.

Including the elements above, in 2026/27 people who live in North Yorkshire will pay £655.301 million in council tax.

This money will go to the following:

Council Tax bands

Your council tax demand notice is based upon your council tax banding figure which relates to the capital value of your property in 1991. Based on the value of your property on 1st April 1991 your home has been allocated to one of eight possible bands. These council tax bands are then used to determine the level of council tax you need to pay.

The amount of council tax payable by a resident is calculated by dividing each requirement (precept) by the number of properties in the relevant area that are equivalent to a Band 'D'. In 2026/27 the overall number of Band D equivalent properties is 257,552.26 The tax you then pay for other bands is calculated on 9ths of a Band D property.

So, for example, a Band A property would pay 6/9th (i.e. two thirds) of the Band D amount and a Band H 18/9ths (i.e. double) the band D figure.
