Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath, 10.36/1/1 & 10.161/7/1 in the Parish of Dalton & Topcliffe, between grid reference SE43077715 and SE43107844 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 5th March 2026 to 11th August 2026 due to unsafe bridges.


This Order follows Emergency Notice No 25.
