Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)


North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpath, 15.54/160/3 in the Parish of Harrogate between grid reference SE31115844 and SE30645785 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 11th March 2026 and 17th August 2026 due to the landslip, the route continues to be unsafe for members of the public to use. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 47 which commenced on 18th February 2026.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
