Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

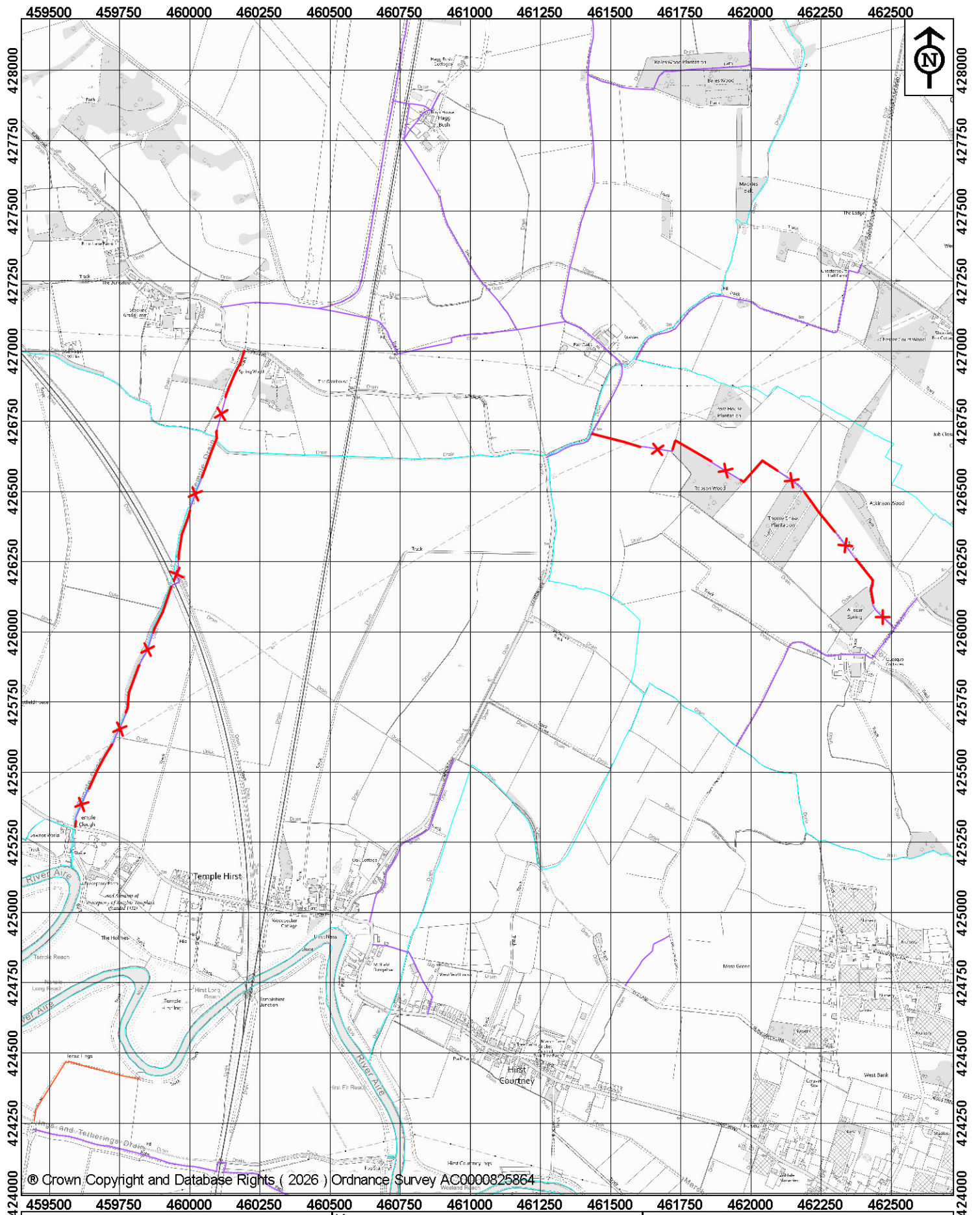
North Yorkshire Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths, 35.14/10/1 in the Parish of Burn, 35.66/1/1 in the Parish of Temple Hirst and 35.18/4/1 in the Parish of Carlton, between grid references SE60192701, SE59592530 and SE61432670, SE62502601 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 8th April 2026 and 7th October 2026 due to overhead line refurbishment works.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
