**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 10.49/5, BLACKCOLLAR BARN, FARLINGTON,
DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

On 24th February 2026 North Yorkshire Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the Public Footpath described below and modify The District of Hambleton (Outside the North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement accordingly.

Public Footpath No.10.49/5 between GR46177 46741 and GR46167 46743 will be diverted onto a new route in a Southwest direction between GR46177 46741 and GR46170 46737.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Easingwold Community Library, Market Place, Easingwold, North Yorkshire, YO61 3AN until 17th April 2026. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from Countryside Access Service, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2.00, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

The Order comes into force on 24th February 2026, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 6th March 2026, make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Public Footpath in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Public Footpath should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.


Matthew and Georgette Sunderland, Blackcollar Barn, Farlington, York, YO61 1NR have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Farlington Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Blackcollar Barn, Farlington described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. There shall from the date of confirmation be a Public Footpath over the land situated at Blackcollar Barn, Farlington described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by adding that Public Footpath to it.
3. The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.


