(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (MAIN STREET, WATER LANE, KIRK SMEATON) **ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 20th March 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

Road	Length
Main Street, Water Lane, Kirk Smeaton	Extent of Limit – 352m North from Rectory Court, Main Street to the east boundary of The Willows Water Lane.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 1st April 2026, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Parish Notice Board, Kirk Smeaton during normal office hours from 26th March 2026 until 1st May 2026 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 20th March 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
