**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)**  
**(B6265/5/85 YORK ROAD, BOROUGHBIDGE) (NO 45) ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that on 06 March 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to introduce the restrictions specified in the table below:-

**WAITING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES WITH EXEMPTIONS**

1.	B6265/5/85 York Road, Boroughbridge	From a point 14m Northwest of the Centre Line of Greenways, along the Northern kerb Line. To a point 23.5m away in a South Easterly Direction.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 06 March 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
