**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)**

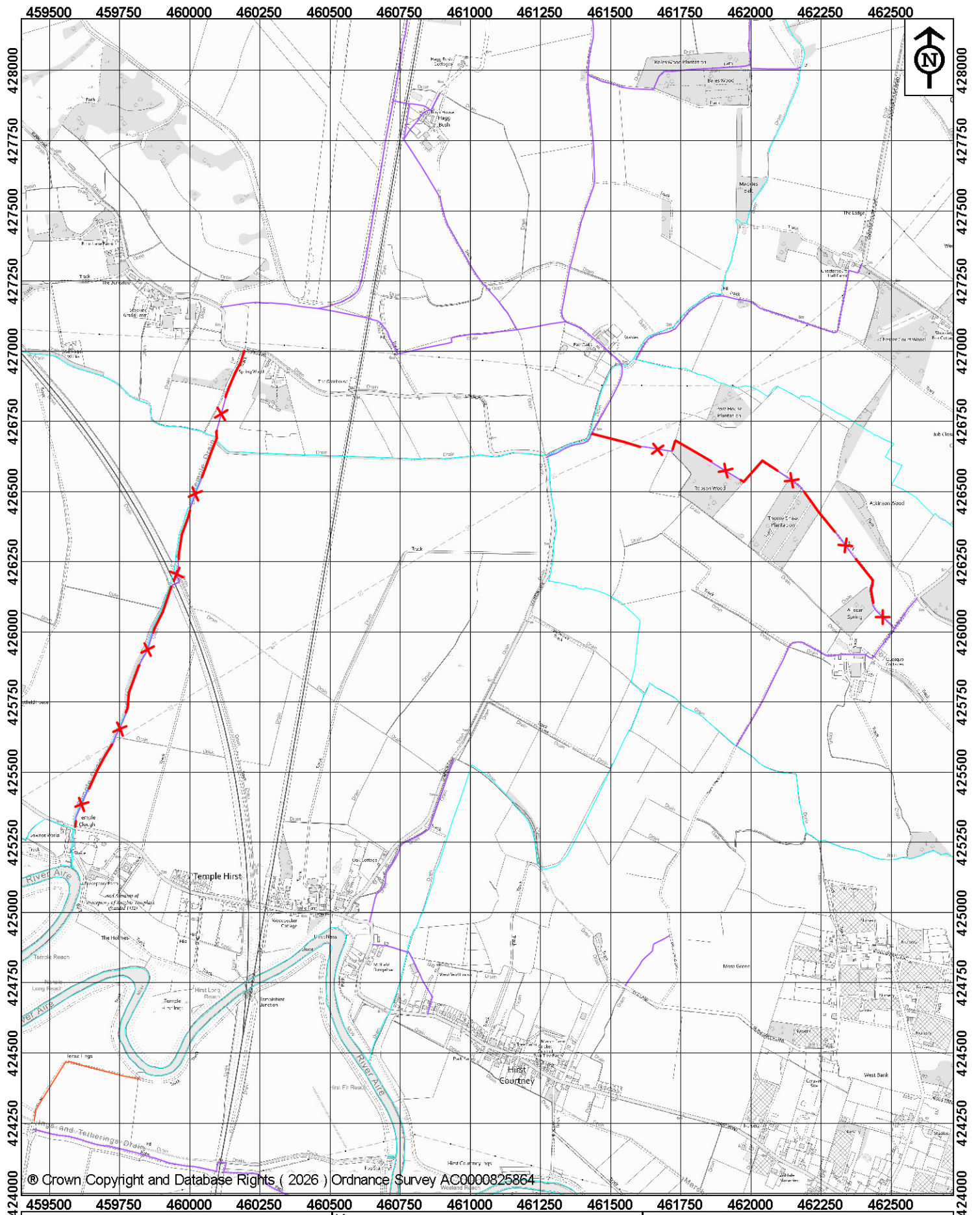
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths, 35.14/10/1 in the Parish of Burn, 35.66/1/1 in the Parish of Temple Hirst and 35.18/4/1 in the Parish of Carlton, between grid references SE60192701, SE59592530 and SE61432670, SE62502601 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 8<sup>th</sup> April 2026 and 7<sup>th</sup> October 2026 due to overhead line refurbishment works.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
