**ORDER 2026**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that on 10 April 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to introduce the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-
