(20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(MAIN STREET, SCAGGLETHORPE) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 24 April 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour and 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Part 1 and Part 2 below.

Part 1

ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF SCAGGLETHORPE

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Main Street	From point measured 70 metres from the junction with the A64 to a point measured 41 metres from the centre of Southfields Junction.

ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF SCAGGLETHORPE

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Main Street	From its junction with the A64 – 70 metres – to the access at the Ham and Cheese (PH.)

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 24 April 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
