

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(20, 30 AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) **(VARIOUS ROADS, SICKLINGHALL) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 17 April 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 below, from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 below and from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 3 below.

SCHEDULE 1 **20MPH SPEED LIMIT**

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Main Street, Sicklinghall	From its junction with Park Lane / Kirkby Lane in an easterly direction for 848 metres.
2.	Back Lane, Sicklinghall	From its junction with Main Street to its junction with Longlands Lane (for its entirety).
3.	Stokeld Lane, Sicklinghall	From its junction with Main Street for a distance of 97 metres.
4.	Longlands Lane, Sicklinghall	From its junction with Main Street to its junction with Back Lane.
5.	Stokeld Lane, Sicklinghall	From its junction with Wetherby Road to its junction with Stokeld Lane.

SCHEDULE 2 **30MPH SPEED LIMIT**

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Longlands Lane, Sicklinghall	115 metres south of its junction with Back Lane for a distance of 766 metres in a southerly direction.
2.	Stockeld Lane, Sicklinghall	97 metres from its junction with Main Street / Wetherby Road for a distance of 493 metres in north easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 3 **40MPH SPEED LIMIT**

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Paddock House Lane, Sicklinghall	From its junction with Kirkby Lane in a south easterly direction for a distance of 830 metres.
2.	Kirkby Lane, Sicklinghall	From a point 125 metres west of its junction with Paddock House Lane for a distance of 732 metres in a north easterly direction.
3.	Wetherby Road, Sicklinghall	From a point 160 metres from its junction with Main Street / Stokeld Lane for a distance of 502 metres to the exiting national speed limit sign.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or

on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 17 April 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
