

# THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

## **(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIOUS ROADS, REIGHTON) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

<b>Column 1 Item</b>	<b>Column 2 Road</b>	<b>Column 3 Length</b>
1	St Helen's Lane, Reighton	For its entire length
2	Cowton Lane, Reighton	For its entire length

A copy of the Order, which comes into force on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2026, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Filey Library, Station Avenue, Filey, YO14 9AE during normal office hours from 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026 until 29<sup>th</sup> May 2026 and also viewed online at [www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map](http://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map) or [www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders](http://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 17<sup>th</sup> April 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
