(20 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMITS) (VARIOUS ROADS, LOW WORSALL AND HIGH WORSALL) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 14th April 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 or 40 miles per hour on any length of road as specified below.

ROAD(S) IN THE PARISH OF LOW WORSALL 20MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Village Road	For its entirety.
2.	Tofts Close	For its entirety.
3.	Manor Close	For its entirety.
4.	De Brus Close	For its entirety.
5.	Church Lane	From its junction with Village Road in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 169 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

ROAD(S) IN THE PARISH OF HIGH WORSALL 40MPH SPEED LIMIT

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Church Lane	From a point 169 metres west from its junction with Village Road in a westerly direction to its junction with U1903/1/50, a distance of approximately 423 metres.
2.	U1903/1/50 (Track from West Lynn To High Worsall)	For its entirety (A distance of approximately 850 metres.
3.	U7061/9/50 & U7061/9/70	From its junction with Church Lane in a westerly then northerly direction for a distance of approximately 282 metres

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that

any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 14th April 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
