(PROHIBITION OF HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES) ((VARIOUS ROADS, CRIDLING STUBBS AND KELLINGLY) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle (i.e. any goods vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes) from proceeding along any road or length of road specified in the following Schedule, except for certain permitted purposes which include access to or from premises situated on or adjacent to any of those roads, for the purposes of agriculture on land accessible from and only from any of those roads or for the garaging, servicing or repairing of a vehicle at premises accessible from and only from any of those roads.

ROAD(S) IN THE VILLAGE/PARISHES OF VARIOUS ROADS, CRIDLING STUBBS AND KELLINGLY
