West Pier forms a vital part of Scarborough's South Bay, serving as both a working harbour and a popular visitor destination.

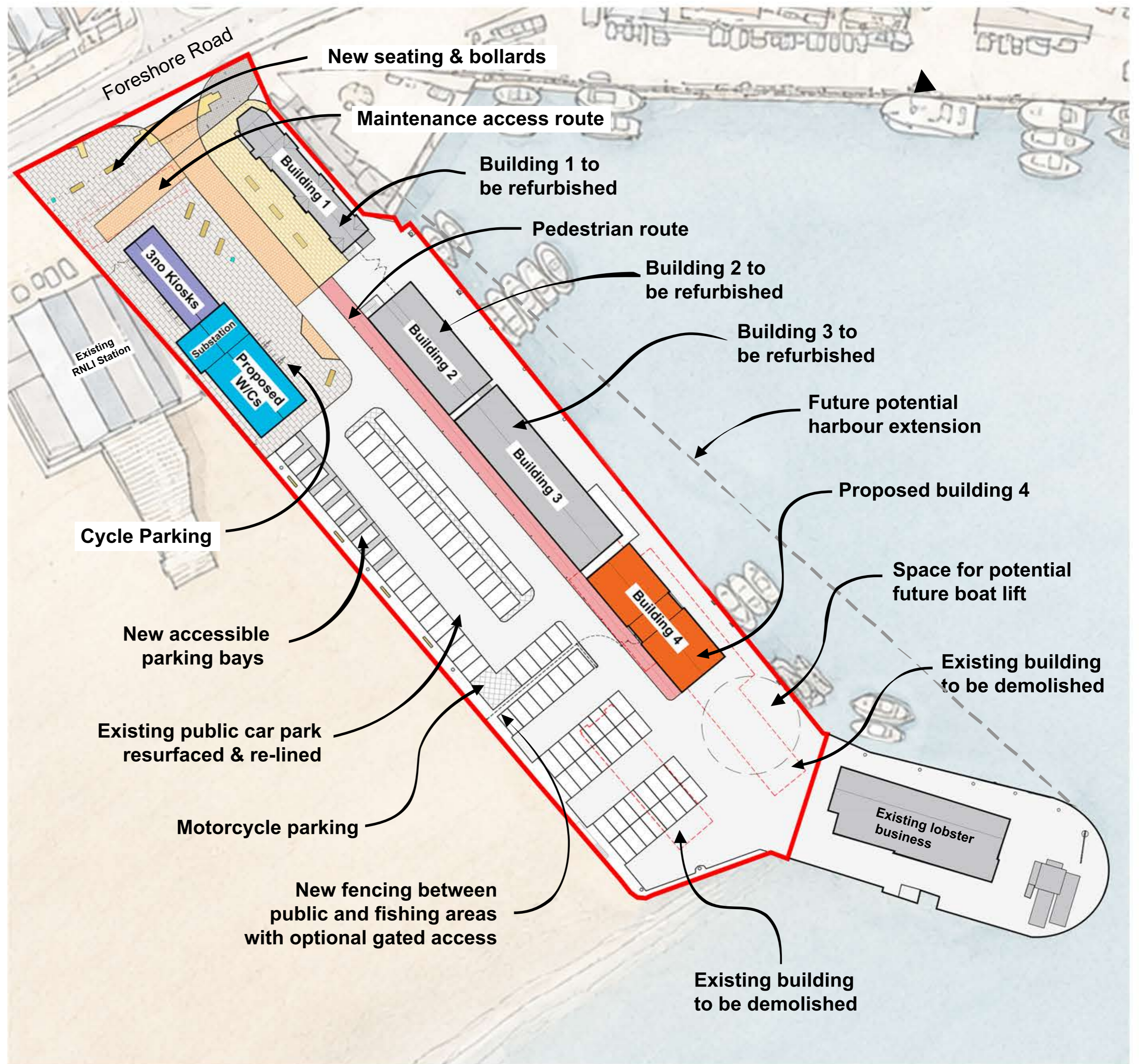
North Yorkshire Council is proposing to revitalise the pier, ensuring it continues to support business whilst becoming a more accessible, attractive and sustainable space.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The West Pier redevelopment is part of a strategy to strengthen links between the town centre, seafront and visitor economy.

The proposals will:

- Restore and refurbish historic buildings, bringing them back into active use.
- Replace deteriorated structures with modern, flood-resilient buildings for commercial use.
- Provide new business opportunities, kiosks, public facilities and improved infrastructure to the pier's entrance.
- Enhance the public realm, creating safer, more accessible and clearer pedestrian routes.
