Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as
amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using the Public Bridleways 35.33/8/3, 35.33/8/4, 35.33/8/2, and 35.33/8/1 in the Parish of Healaugh, between grid references SE50044755 and SE48714638 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 27th May 2026 and 5th November 2026 due to an unsafe bridge.

This Order follows Emergency Notice No 95.

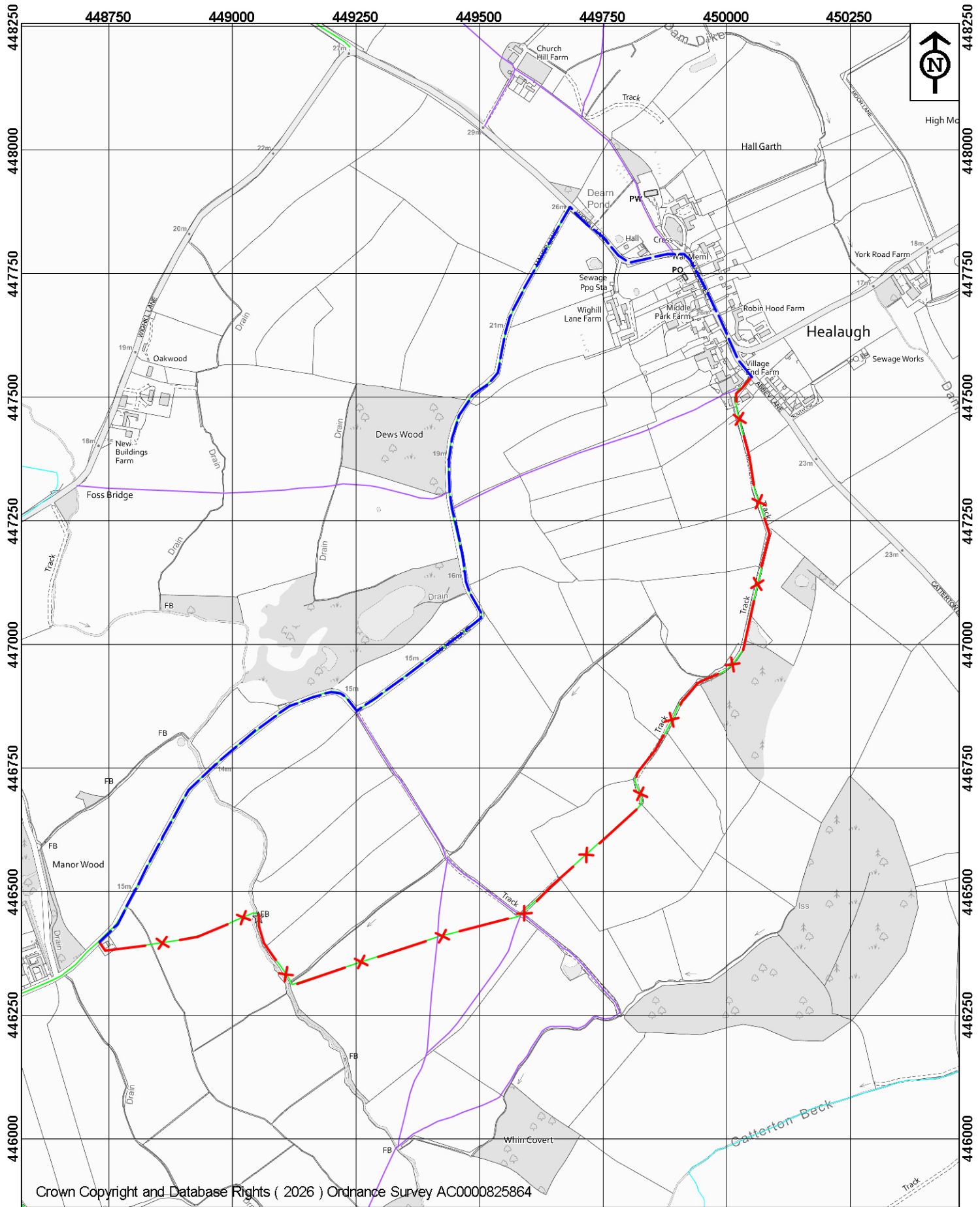
The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will also be signed on site where appropriate.

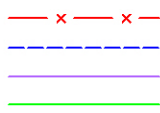
