**IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION TO RECORD AN HISTORIC
EVENT IN THE COMMONS REGISTER UNDER SCHEDULE 3 OF THE
COMMONS ACT 2006 AND SCHEDULE 4 PARAGRAPH 19 OF THE
COMMONS REGISTRATION (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2014**

CLAPHAM COMMON (CL209) AND BURN MOOR (CL270)

An application has been made to North Yorkshire Council by Pauline Hird and Yvonne Gibson under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with Schedule 4(19) of the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The application sought to register a historic severance of the grazing rights attached to land registered at CL209 right entry 5, exercisable over Clapham Common and to the same land registered at CL270 right entry 2, exercisable over Burn Moor.

The Registration Authority is satisfied that the application complies with the requirements of Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and Schedule 4 Paragraph 19 of the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 with regard to the historic severance. In consequence, the Commons Registration Authority has determined that the application be granted.

The Registration Authority has therefore amended the Common Land Register unit numbers CL209 and CL270, in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 to reflect the historic severance, with the rights registered as attached to land at CL209 right entry 5 and CL270 right entry 2 becoming rights held in gross.
