(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(VARIOUS ROADS, SCARBOROUGH) (AMENDMENT NO 85) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that on 1st May 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Scarborough) Order 2007” and “The Borough of Scarborough (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) Consolidation Order 2011” by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedules below:-
