(20 MPH AND 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIOUS ROADS, DISHFORTH) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour and 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 below. The orders specified in column 2 in Schedule 3 below are to be revoked in their entirety: -

ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF DISHFORTH

20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Back Lane (U779/2/70), Dishforth Village	From a point 12 metres South West of the centre line of its junction with U777/2/30 Dishforth Village to a point 508 metres away measured along the centre line of Back Lane in a Southerly Direction.
2.	Grange Close (U3191/2/50), Dishforth Village	In its entirety
3.	Moor Lane (U778/2/70), Dishforth Village	From its junction with U779/2/70 Back Lane to a point 69 metres away in a South Westerly Direction measured along the centre line of Moor Lane

ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF DISHFORTH

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	U777/2/30 Dishforth Village	From a point 86 metres South West of the Centre line of Baynes Drive to a point 115 metres South of its junction with Back Lane (measured along the Western kerb line.)
2.	U780/2/30 Topcliffe Road	In its entirety
