ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which will be to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Craven) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedules below:-

1	Skipton	Cross Street (U2055) (cobbled section)	Northeast	From a point 1.4m northwest of its intersection point with the north western channel line of Gas Street	to a point 23m northwest of its intersection point with the north western channel line of Gas Street	Waiting prohibited at all times with exemptions
2	Skipton	Cross Street (U2055) (cobbled section)	South	From a point 1.6m east of its intersection point with the eastern channel line of Cavendish Street	to a point 27.3m east of its intersection point with the eastern channel line of Cavendish Street	Waiting prohibited at all times with exemptions
