

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(AMENDMENT NO TBC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (Borough of Scarborough) Consolidation Order 2011” by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING

Location	Road	Side	From	To	Nature of Restriction
Scarborough	Caxton Way	Southeast	a point 11 metres south of the termination point of Claxton Way	for a distance of 190 metres in a generally southerly then south easterly direction	No waiting at any time.
Scarborough	Caxton Way	Northeast	a point 30 metres south of the termination point of Claxton Way	for a distance of 287 metres in a generally south easterly and then northerly direction onto Thornburgh Road.	No waiting at any time.
Scarborough	Thornburgh Road	East	a point 287 metres North of the centre of the junction of Great Hill	for a distance of 39 metres in a Northernly direction	No waiting at any time.
Scarborough	Thornburgh Road	East	a point 336 metres North of the centre of the junction of Great Hill	for a distance of 59 metres in a generally Northernly direction	No waiting at any time.
