**ORDER 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 05 June 2026 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF GATE HELMSLEY

30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	Upper Helmsley Road, Gate Helmsley	For a distance of 90 metres north, from the northern boundary of property Stone Lea at the existing 30mph speed limit signage.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 05 June 2026 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
