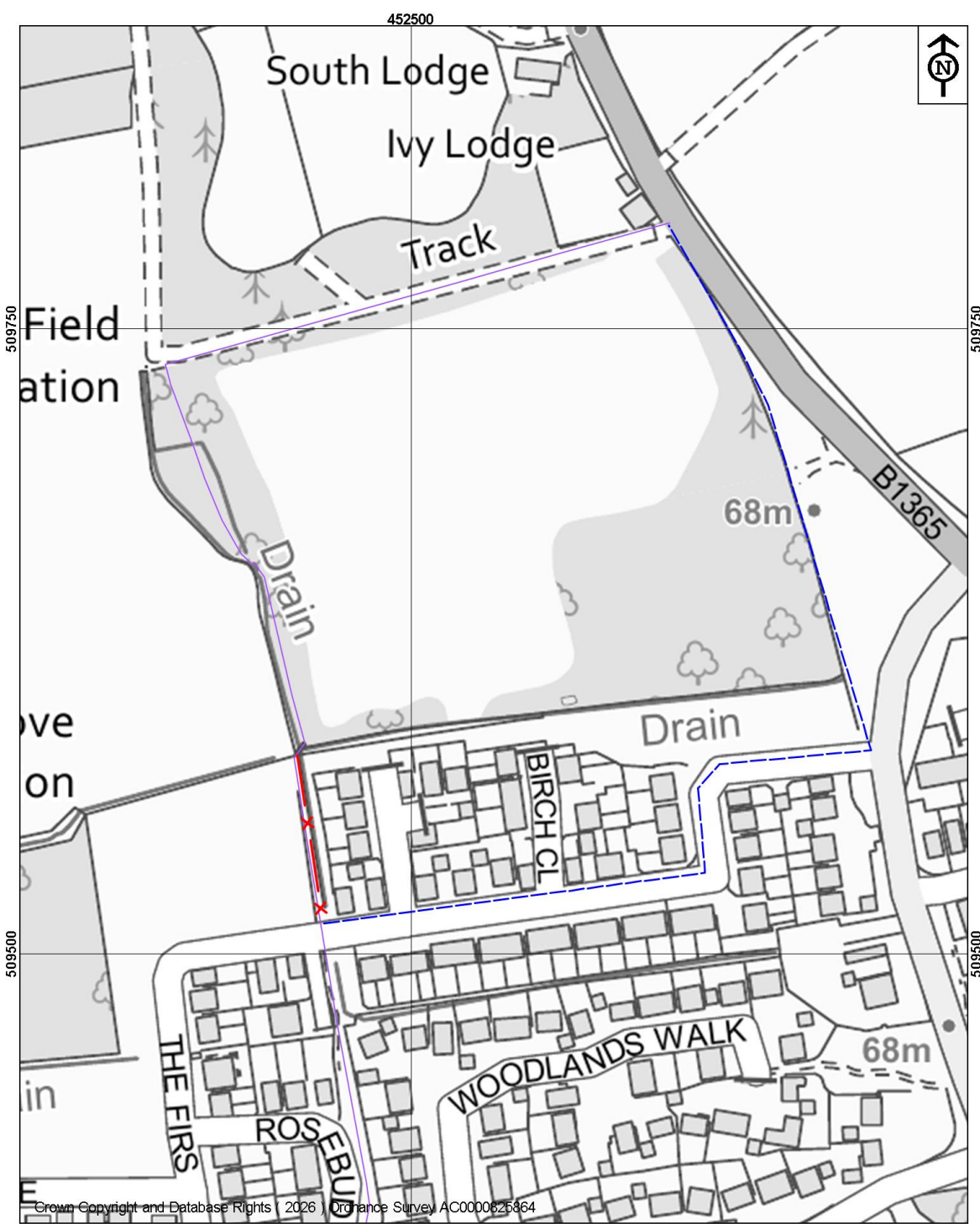
North Yorkshire Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpath 10.140/3/1 in the Parish of Stokesley, between grid references NZ52450958 and NZ52480933 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 6th July 2026 and 5th January 2027 due to construction traffic, pedestrian/site safety.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
