Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

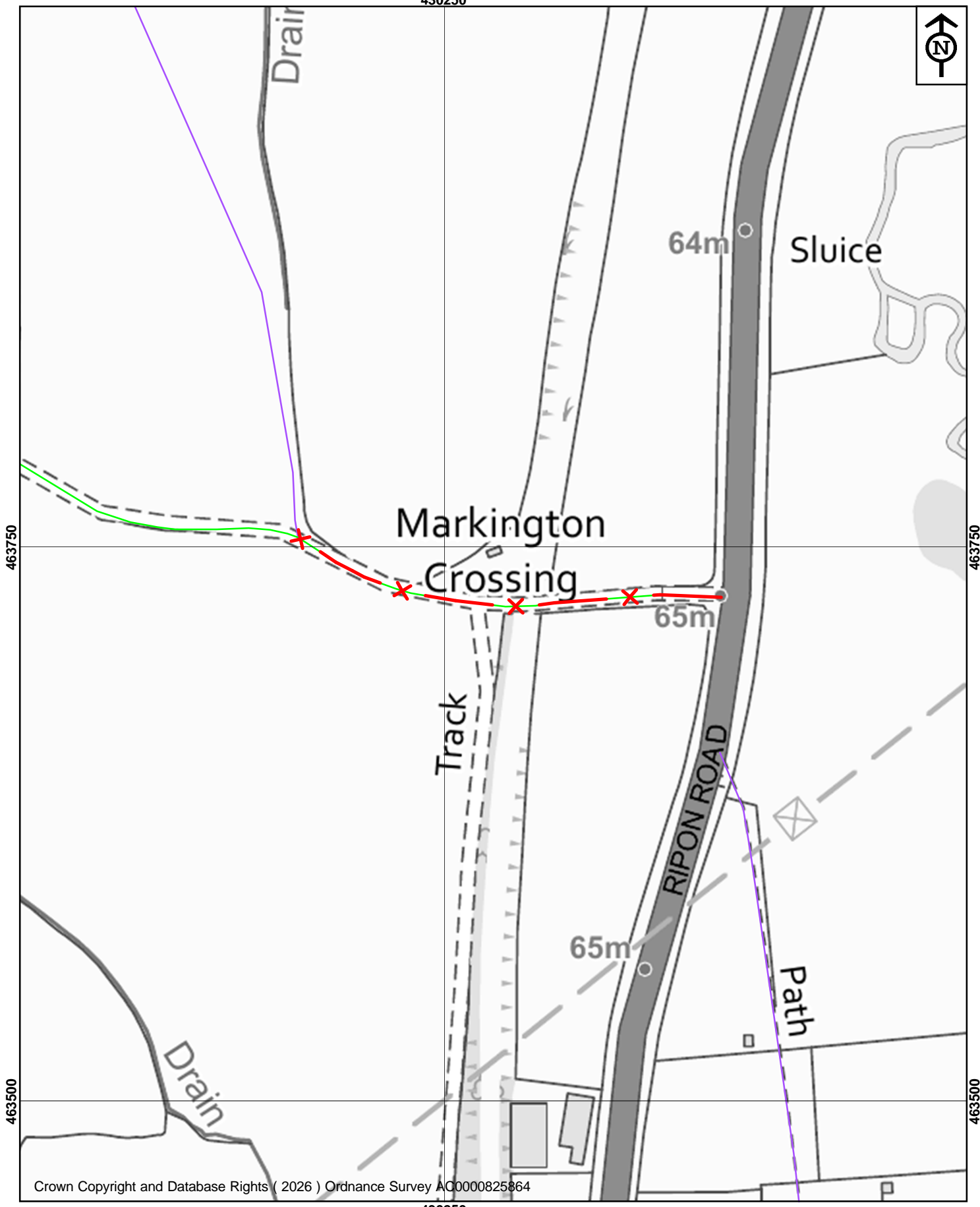
North Yorkshire Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist or person riding or leading a horse from using the Public Bridleway 15.121/8/2 in the Parish of South Stainley with Cayton, between grid references SE30186375 and SE30376372 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 19th June 2026 and 18th December 2026 due to risk to public whilst works are carried out.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
