North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 25.24/2/1 in the Parish of Coulton & 25.49/14/1 in the parish of Hovingham, between grid references SE63587416 & SE64347465 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 10th June 2026 and 19th November 2026 due to unsafe footbridge.

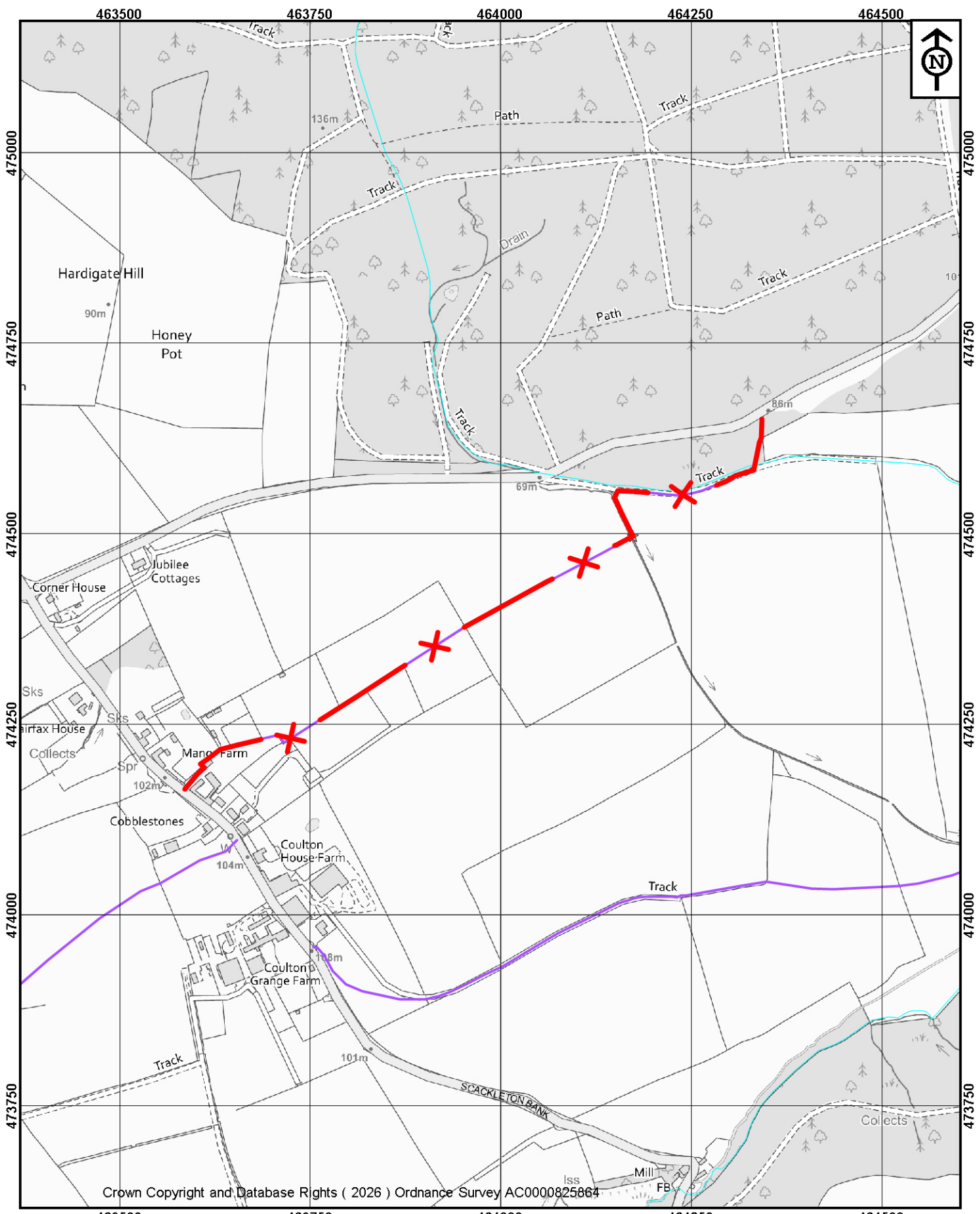
This Order follows Emergency Notice No 109
