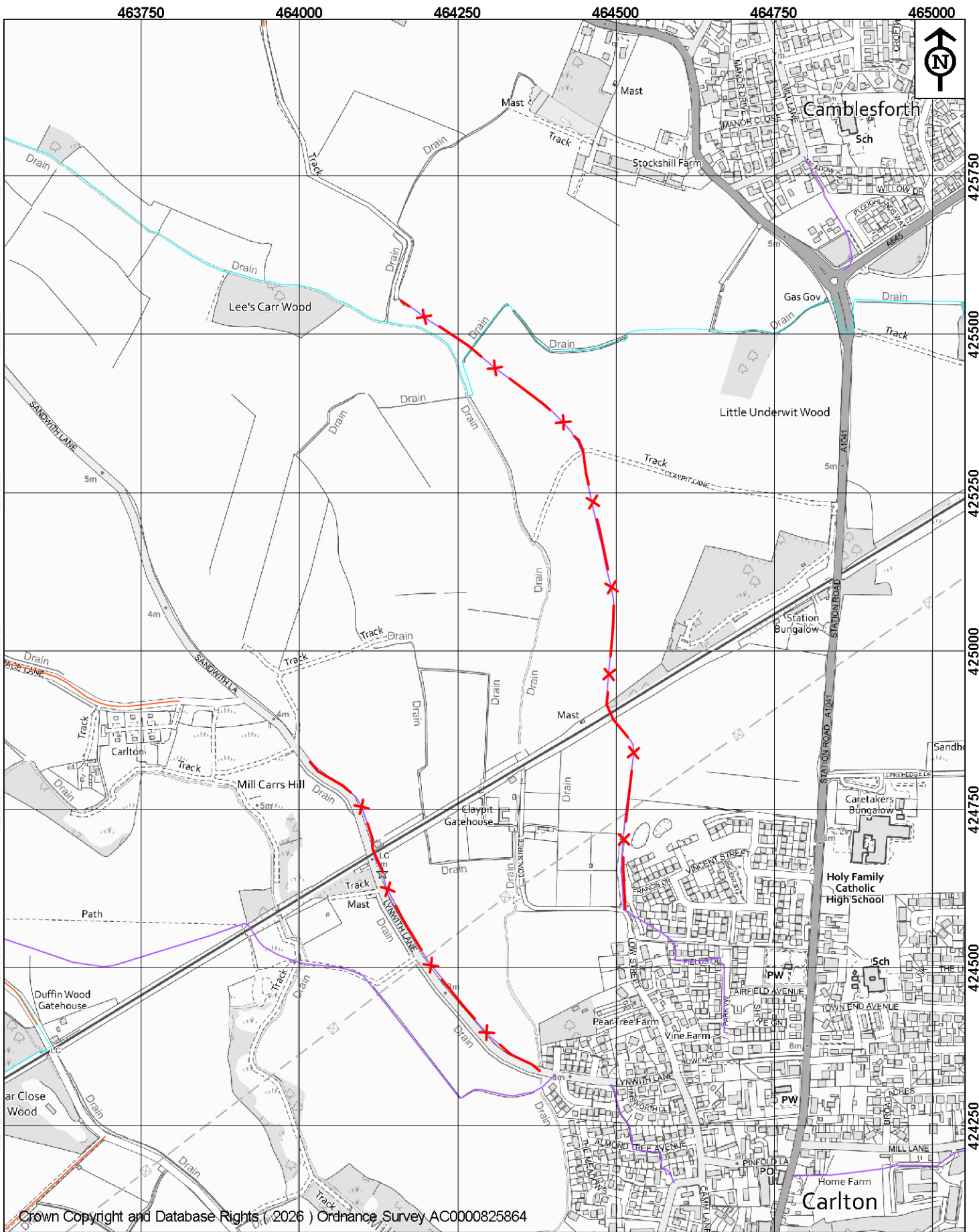
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 35.18/5/1 & 35.18/6/1 in the Parish of Carlton, between grid references SE64152555, SE64522458 and SE64012482, SE64382434 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 18th June 2026 and 17th December 2026 due to refurbishment works being carried out on Overhead Lines.

The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
