ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

ROAD IN THE PARISH OF SELBY

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

1.	A19 / Barlby Road, Selby	For a distance of 807 metres in a westerly direction from the existing 40mph speed limit.
