

PROPOSED 40mph SPEED LIMIT: Barlby Road Selby and Barlby New By-Pass Barlby.

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order on one or more of the grounds contained in Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

1. for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
2. for improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs,

The proposal seeks to achieve the following:

Barlby Road, Selby and Barlby New By-Pass, Barlby

- The new 40mph speed limit from the existing 40mph speed limit for 807m in the westerly direction. The existing 30mph speed limit is inappropriate due to the lack of residential and commercial development and properties and characteristics of the road.
- The proposals are illustrated on Plan BRS-BNBPB1

1. Creation of a 40mph speed limit:

Road	Length
