**NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

RESTRICTED BYWAY NO. 10.31/17, GREEN GATE LANE, CRAKEHALL DIVERSION ORDER 2026

The above Order, made on 3 July 2026, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the restricted byway described below and modify The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement accordingly.

Restricted byway No. 10.31/17 between SE 2478 9053 and SE 2495 9045 will be diverted onto a new route in a generally east north east then south east direction along the farm track between SE 2478 9053 and SE 2495 9045.

Please note – the above diversion will only come into effect on confirmation of the related Definitive Map Modification Order HAM/2017/09/DMMO.

A copy of the Order and Order Map may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Bedale Community Library, North Yorkshire until 21 August 2026. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire, DL7 8AD (tel: 01609 532512) at a cost of £2.00, or can be downloaded free from our website www.northyorks.gov.uk/pathnotices.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Suzanne Williamson, Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire DL7 8AD not later than 21 August 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The North Yorkshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

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DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

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**RESTRICTED BYWAY NO. 10.31/17, GREEN GATE LANE, CRAKEHALL
DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Restricted Byway described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Restricted Byway should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement.

Mr Trevor Pounder, Green Gate Farm, Little Crakehall, Bedale, North Yorkshire, DL8 1LD has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the Restricted Byway into a fit condition for use by the public.

Crakehall with Langthorne Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Green Gate Farm, Little Crakehall described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. There shall from the date of confirmation be a Restricted Byway over the land situated at Green Gate Farm, Little Crakehall described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by adding that Restricted Byway to it.
3. The District of Hambleton (Outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

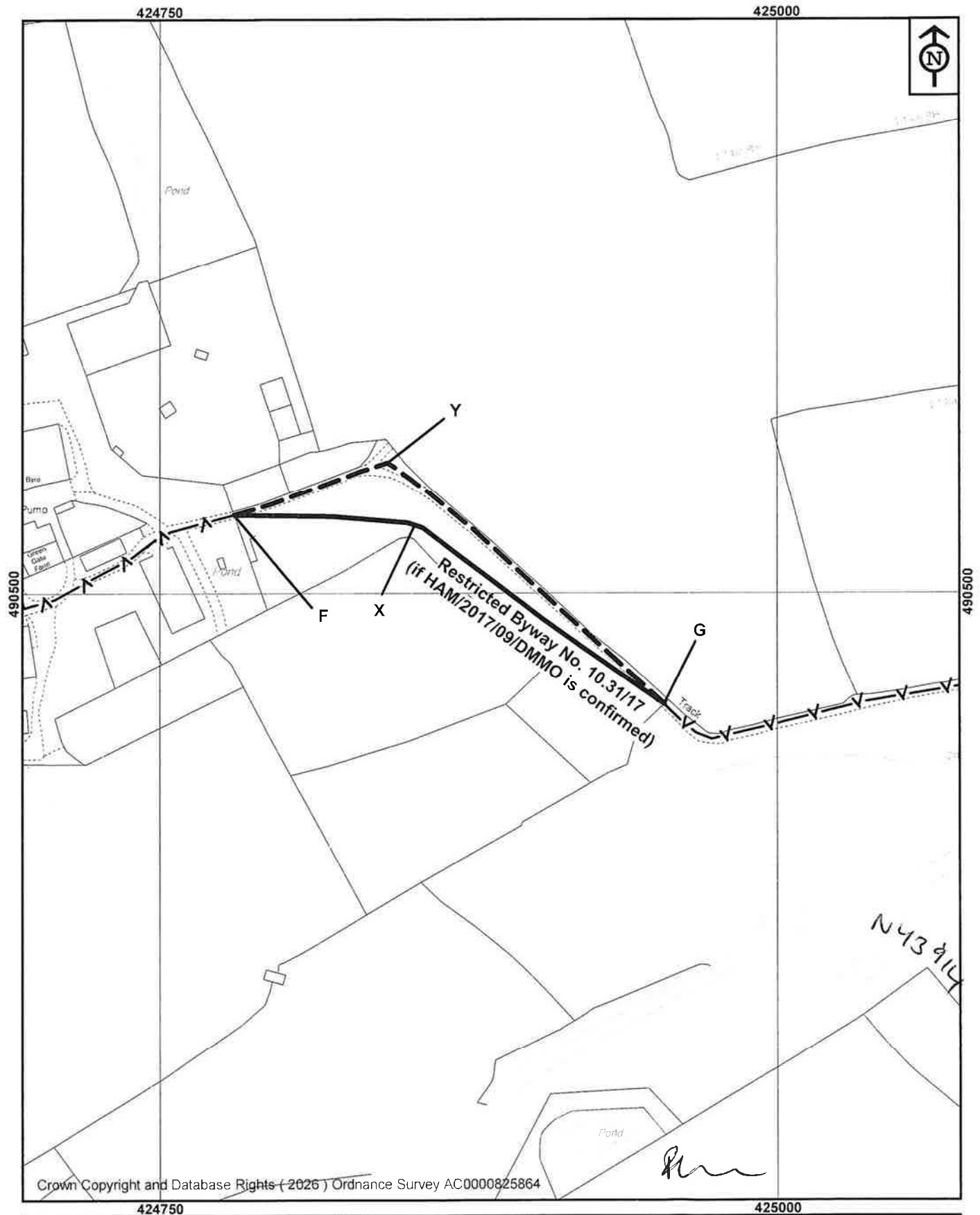
